The Schmetterlings are a pop punk anomaly fluttering somewhere between chaos and catharsis. Self-described as “a band from the Ether,” they don’t just write songs—they intercept them, pulling jagged hooks and glittering melodies out of some strange, unseen frequency. Their sound starts with a pop punk backbone—punchy guitars and restless rhythms—but refuses to stay contained.

At the core of their identity is a rotating guest vocalist—an ever-shifting voice that transforms each album into something entirely new.
